

District Boundary Proposal

This proposal is to establish a mechanism for NSRCA members to more easily affiliate with a district that might better serve the members' needs. It will allow members to affiliate with a district that better suits their location and contest attendance without having possible negative effects on fellow members residing in a district that do not desire any changes.

Members will be allowed to designate their desired NSRCA district affiliation, regardless of actual geographical district boundaries. Members residing within a particular district and wanting to remain in that district are not affected by this proposal and no action on their part is required.

Members desiring to change their district affiliation will do so at the time of dues renewal by sending in their request, with their dues payment, to the NSRCA Secretary. Such a district change will be effective for the year of the submitted renewal; at the end of that period, the member's district affiliation will revert to his geographic district unless he has submitted a change request with that year's membership renewal.

This information will be recorded in the NSRCA database and the two district VP's involved shall be notified of the district change. New members will be able to select their affiliation at the time of enrollment and payment of dues, with the appropriate recording and notifications, previously mentioned. Members will be allowed only one designated move per enrollment year, with an exception allowed for anyone having a physical relocation within that year.

Members residing in one district and affiliating with another district, will be considered to be full members of their chosen district and assume all of the benefits and responsibilities of that district only.

NSRCA districts will retain all geographical boundaries as they are currently established. All contests held within the boundaries of an NSRCA district, will be considered to be in that NSRCA district.

Special Provision A:

Upon adoption of this proposal and this amendment, any NSRCA member will be allowed to designate his/her district affiliation from June 15, 2005 through

July 31, 2005 for the year 2005 and will be considered retroactive to January 01, 2005
