



Rules Proposal Committee 2005 Committee Charter

Procedure Guidelines:

- The NSRCA President shall be the focal point for communications between the Committee Chairperson and the Board on all matters of directive nature, and for deliverables from the Committee.
- NSRCA Board members (executive officers and District vice presidents) shall not be voting members of the Committee. If they are asked to contribute to the committee, they will be acting in an advisory capacity only.
- The Chairperson will select members for his committee, and propose a team to the NSRCA Board.
- NSRCA Board will review the team for national balance and representation across Intermediate through Masters classes, and provide recommendations on them to the Chairperson on the membership of the committee.
- The Chairperson and committee members agree to work as a team and reach a consensus on the Committee's proposals. They agree to support the Committee's proposal and not submit separate proposals on these Rules to AMA.
- The Committee shall perform their tasks within the schedule of milestones as defined by Board.
- Committee will produce an integrated survey on all proposed Sequence and Rules changes and provide to the Board for approval. The Board shall provide comments and the Chairperson will update and prepare the survey to be published in the K Factor along with the proposed rules changes from the Sequence Proposal Committee.
- The Board shall collect, tabulate and distribute results from the Survey, and coordinate the resulting responses and actions with the Rules Proposal and Sequence Proposal Committee Chairpersons.
- Committee will produce the final Rules and Sequence proposals, with all supporting rationale to be approved by NSRCA board before submission to AMA by September of the submitting year.

Primary Sequence of Events:

- The Committee will propose new rules, clarify existing rules, amend maneuver descriptions and remove old rules as the Committee members agree are necessary.
